**December 6, 2007**

The Historic Preservation Review Board held a special meeting and public hearing on Thursday, December 6, 2007 for the purpose of concluding the Board's consideration of the pending nomination of the Third Church of Christ, Scientist and Christian Science Monitor Building complex for possible landmark designation. This hearing was a continuation of the case as opened and discussed at the Board's November 1, 2007 meeting.

**HISTORIC LANDMARK NOMINATION**

Third Church of Christ Scientist and Christian Science Monitor Building, 900-918 16th Street and 1601-1605 I Street, NW, Case #91-05.

**The staff report recommended the Review Board designate the complex as a District of Columbia landmark. Contingent upon the assent of the property owner, it is further recommended that the application be forwarded to the National Register of the Historic Places with a recommendation that the property meets the National Register criteria for designation as of statewide significance. The landmark nomination was approved by a vote of 7-0.**
